HEMLOCK VALLEY ROAD CEMETERY

Location: Approximately half-way between Lake Erroch and Harrison Mills is the Hemlock Valley Road that cuts off the Lougheed Highway at the Sasquatch Inn. 2.7 miles up the Road there is a small cemetery on the left, nestled into the corner of a bluff. The cemetery has a piled granite fence with a large wrought-iron gate.
