"AGASSIZ CEMETERY"


"ON THIS HILLSIDE MANY PIONEERS OF THE AGASSIZ, HARRISON AND HARRISON MILLS DISTRICTS ARE BURIED. THE SITE WAS CHOSED BECAUSE IT IS HIGH ABOVE THE FLOOD MARK. THE FIRST PLAN WAS DRAWN UP IN 1900 BY CAPTAIN WILLIAM S. JENNETT, ALTHOUGH THE FIRST BURIAL WAS THAT OF ESTHER ANN HUBBARD, AGE 29, IN 1899.

AT THE TOP ARE THE GRAVES OF THREE OF THE AGASSIZ FAMILY; MRS. MARY CAROLINE AGASSIZ, ONE OF HER DAUGHTERS AND HER ELDEST SON. NEARBY IS THE GRAVE OF ONE OF THE SONS-IN-LAW, CAPTAIN MOORE. SNOWDROPS GROW IN PROFUSION AROUND THESE GRAVES. THE AGASSIZ FAMILY CAME HERE IN 1867. AMONG THE GRAVES ARE THOSE OF MANY CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF TWELVE. IN 1929 THREE OF THE CHINESE BODIES INTERRED HERE WERE REMOVED TO OTHER PLACES FOR SECOND BURIALS.

CARVED ON THE MARKERS WERE SCOTTISH, IRISH, FRENCH, CHINESE AND ANGLO-SAXON NAMES. ROMAN CATHOLICS, PROTESTANTS, BUDDISTS AND NON-BELIEVERS LIE SIDE BY SIDE. FIVE GRAVES ARE UNMARKED, THE NAMES OF THE INTERRED UNKNOWN.

THIS CEMETERY WAS OFFICIALLY CLOSED ON MAY 5, 1981, ALTHOUGH IT WAS SELDOM USED AFTER 1936 WHEN VALLEY VIEW CEMETERY WAS OPENED."


