CADWALLADER PRIVATE CEMETERY, PORT HARDY, BC

Location: Lot 2, Sec 18, Rupert District, PI 24411.

Marked as "R. Hunt's graveyard" on plan in provincial cemetery file.

Located just past Indian Reserve near sit of old Fort Rupert and Hunt's store near the Port Hardy Airport. The Cadwalladers were descendents of Robert Hunt the last factor of Fort Rupert. Robert Hunt bought the fort property in 1873.

There are about 5 unmarked mounds, several unmarked cement slabs and possibly other burials.
