

# 100 MILE HOUSE MUNICIPAL CEMETERY, 100 MILE HOUSE, BC

(Published in BC Genealogist, February 1974, Volume 32, Number 2, p 12-19 © BCGS)

100 Mile House was originally a road house on the Old Cariboo Trail. First owner was Thomas Miller who built the house about 1862-3. After changing ownership several times, it was taken over by the Marquis of Exeter in 1912 along with surrounding lands.<sup>1</sup> 100 Mile was incorporated Saturday, June 26, 1965. Prior to this, land was only available for lease from Bridge Creek Estate, a company established by Lord Martin Cecil, son of the Marquis. Under the lease system, there were no joint privileges according to the Municipal Act. Although Bridge creek Estate had provided adequate municipal services, it was a majority feeling that village affairs should be in the hands of a municipal council and this was further enhanced by a tax income of \$25,000 previously spent elsewhere.<sup>2</sup>
